RULES & REGULATIONS

The Diamond Classic will be organized under the Singapore Levels Program:

WAG

- Singapore National Program WAG (Feb 2019 Version)
- SG National Competition Policy (Oct 2021 Version)

MAG

- Singapore National Program MAG (Oct 2018 Version)
- SG National Competition Policy (Oct 2021 Version)

ELIGIBILITY

TRAINING INSTITUTION

- Any athletes from a local/international school gymnastics program and private club are welcome to participate in the Diamond Classic Event.
- All participating athletes must be accompanied by a coach who is named on the registration form.
- All participating athletes must be entered under a school or club team.
- An athlete can enter as an individual as long as they are representing a club or school.

VACCINATION

- All athletes 12 years and above are required to be fully vaccinated to participate in the competition.
- All personnel volunteers, coaches and judges are required to be fully vaccinated to participate in the competition.
- No mandated vaccinations for athletes under 12 years
- Covid safe measures will apply

EVENT FORMAT

Individual Competition

- Individual All Around (IAA)
- Apparatus Finals

Team Competition

- Maximum team size: 6
- Maximum two teams per club for each competition category
- Combination of top 3 scores of each club / school on each event, across all apparatus, per level, per age group
- Clubs/Schools entering 2 teams must define the athletes in the A and B teams in the registration form.

^{*}Team competition will only be held if there's a minimum of 3 teams per category

AWARDS & CEREMONIES

WAG SG Levels 2-5

MAG SG Fundamentals & Levels 1-5

Apparatus Ribbons

All athletes will collect a Bronze, Silver or Gold ribbon for each of their apparatus performances

Participation All Around Awards (PAA)

Each participating athlete will be presented a Bronze, Silver or Gold All Around medal based on their average ribbon color.

Best Performance Awards (BPA)

Medals

- Individual All Around (IAA) Medal awarded to places 1-3 Ribbons 4-6
- Individual Apparatus Winners Medal awarded to places 1-3

Team Awards

Trophy

- Team trophies are awarded to the top 3 performing teams for the level
- Depending on the total number of teams entered for the junior and senior categories in each level, team awards will be separated into junior and senior categories.

AGE CUT OFF

Age categories are based on the age the athlete is as of 1st January 2022

- Level 4 MAG (open Age)
