ELIGIBILITY	 TRAINING INSTITUTION Any athletes from a local/international school gymnastics program and private club are welcome to participate in the Lion Classic Event. All participating athletes must be accompanied by a coach who is named on the registration form. All participating athletes must be entered under a school or club team. An athlete can enter as an individual as long as they are representing a club or school. VACCINATION We will follow the most up to date sport specific guidelines Currently all athletes 12 years and above are required to be fully vaccinated to participate in the competition. All personnel volunteers, coaches and judges are required to be fully vaccinated to participate in the competition. No mandated vaccinations for athletes under 12 years Covid safe measures will apply
